#### **Q & A**

- \* Registration and rosters are due ASAP.
- \* Full payment is due by July 1.
- \* Please call the office if you have special circumstances or concerns; we will work with you.
- \* Changes are inevitable; please communicate these to the office.
- \* Late registration after July 1, is \$170 per person.
- \* We want you to bring your young people even if you register them last-minute at the conference. We will work with you! Please communicate with the office.
- The only forms our CTM Office requires are the registration form, the group roster, the Arise Liability Release, the Smokies Liability Release, and the Secure Check Form (included). All chaperones 18 and older MUST submit the Secure Check Form prior to entrance of the conference. It is highly recommended that you take care of your church's permission forms, medical release forms, etc. within your own youth group and bring them with you to conference in case of an emergency.

## Registration/Main Entrance - LeConte Center

- \* Check-in from 1:00-5:00 p.m. on July 19. (Only one leader needed.)
- \* Checks to CTM-Arise or cash are accepted. Credit cards will only be accepted at the door with an additional processing fee.
- \* Free parking is available at LeConte Center for all vehicles, vans, and buses.

We understand that every church has different standards concerning a dress code. We are asking you, as a group leader, to make sure each registered delegate has a copy of the Dress Code.

Our goal is to run a clean conference with a practical, yet modest dress code. To help with this, and to be very clear, we have included pictures of what is considered acceptable for conference. Use these photos to communicate with your teenagers what they need to bring to conference. We have found that it can be very embarrassing and hurtful to delegates if they come unprepared. We do not want that to happen!

SO PLEASE HELP US! Be proactive and prepare your teens for conference with this information so once we get there we can have a great time and see lives changed!

Youth leaders and Counselors, please encourage your group to follow the dress code while attending Arise Youth Conference. All fashions worn should be conservative and professing Godliness in appearance.

#### **GIRLS**

**Evening Services:** Please wear skirts or dresses. All skirts and dresses should cover the knee. Shirts should cover the shoulders and midriff. Necklines should be modestly designed and not low cut.

**Morning Services and Activities:** Please wear skirts, dresses, capris, walking shorts (bermuda shorts), or loose fitting garments that are at least knee length.

**Water Activities:** If participating in water activities, please wear one piece swimsuit covered with a dark t-shirt or swim shirt; knee length shorts.

#### **GUYS**

Evening Services: Please wear long, casual pants, (chino or khaki style) or church attire, and shirts with sleeves.

Morning Services and Activities: Please wear long, casual pants, jeans, or shorts, and shirt with sleeves.

Water Activities: If participating in water activities, please wear dark swim trunks and t-shirt or swim shirt.
