- O Full payment is due by July 1. (No Refunds)
- O Please call the office if you have special circumstances or concerns; we will work with you.
- O Changes are inevitable; please communicate these to the office.
- O Late registration July 2-July 14, is \$205 per person.
- We want you to bring your young people even if you register them last-minute at the conference. We will work with you! Please communicate with the office.
- O All chaperones 18 and older MUST submit the Secure Check Form prior to entrance of the conference. It is highly recommended that you take care of your church's permission forms, medical release forms, etc. within your own youth group and bring them with you to the conference.
- O Lodging and meals are not incuded.

Registration/Main Entrance - LeConte Center

- O Check-in from 1:00-6:00 p.m. on July 14. (Only one leader needed. May check in online.)
- O If needed, late registration can be handled at check in.

Youth leaders and Counselors, please encourage your group to follow the dress code while attending Arise Youth Conference. All fashions worn should be conservative and professing Godliness in appearance.

Young Ladies

Evening Services: Please wear skirts or dresses. All skirts and dresses should cover the knee. Shirts should cover the shoulders and midriff. Necklines should be modestly designed and not low cut.

Morning Services and Activities: Please wear skirts, dresses, capris, walking shorts (bermuda shorts), or loose fitting garments that are at least knee length.

Water Activities: If participating in water activities, please wear one piece swimsuit covered with a dark t-shirt or swim shirt; knee-length shorts.
